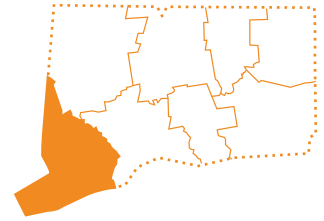


Making a difference in your community: Fairfield County



Since 2013, we have helped more than 1 million individuals and small businesses, and the uninsured rate in our state has been cut in half. This means more residents are getting access to quality care, financial help, and preventive services that they need.

Enrollment in your community

- 35,953 residents enrolled in 2018 Qualified Health Plans during Open Enrollment.
- 161,969 residents were enrolled in Husky Health/Medicaid as of 12/31/17.
- Residents received an average of \$685.89 towards their monthly health insurance bill.

Getting coverage

Access Health CT (AHCT) is Connecticut's health insurance marketplace, created in 2011 to comply with the Affordable Care Act. AHCT works to increase the number of people in Connecticut with health insurance, improve the health of all people in the state, and to help people find their best options for healthcare.

Access Health CT is the only place where customers can get financial help to pay for healthcare coverage, if they qualify.

All health plans include:

- Preventive services – like annual checkups
- Lab tests
- Prescription drugs
- Maternity and pediatric services
- Urgent care and emergency room visits
- Mental health and substance abuse treatment
- Inpatient and outpatient hospital care
- Services and devices for recovery from illness or injury













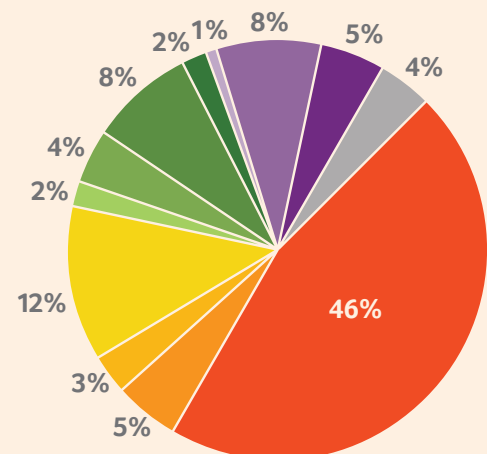
