- Blending large teams in short time

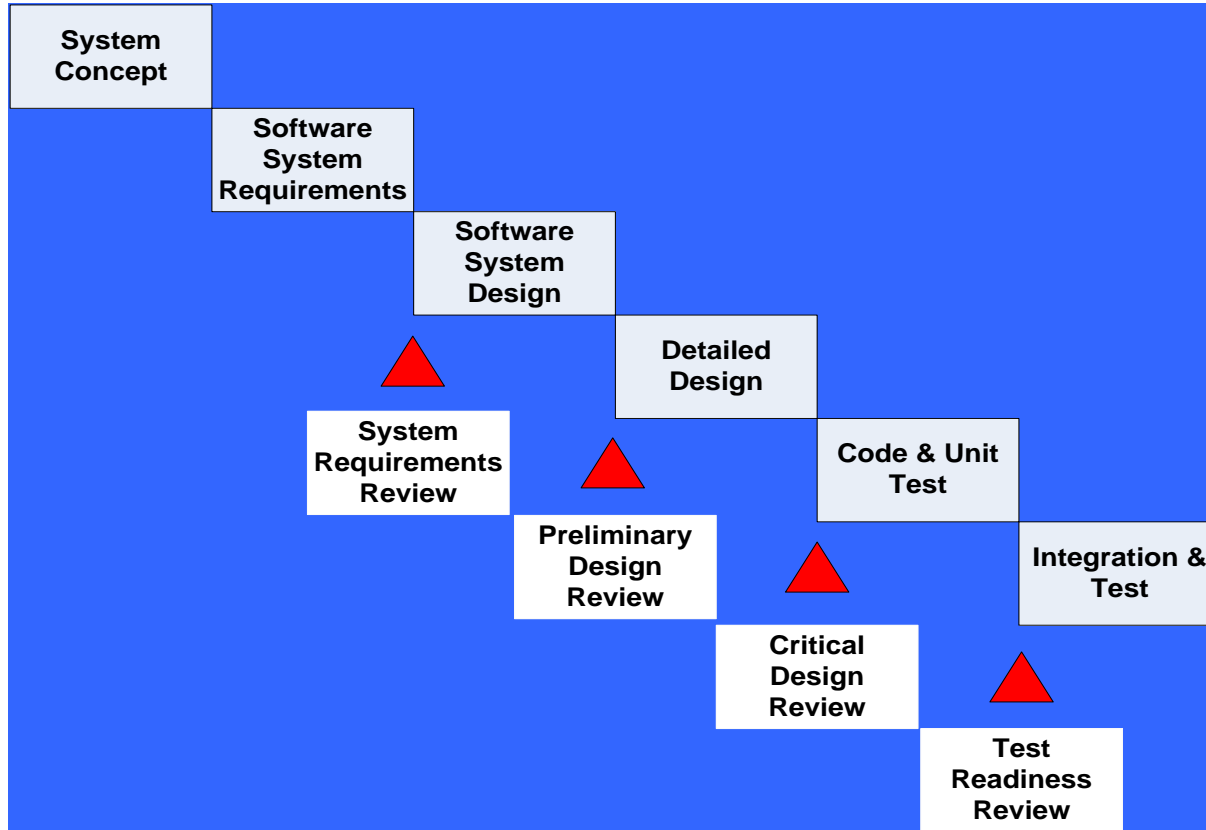
- **Scope**

- Complexity of the solution and integration of multiple systems
- Evolving federal guidance and regulations

- **Quality**

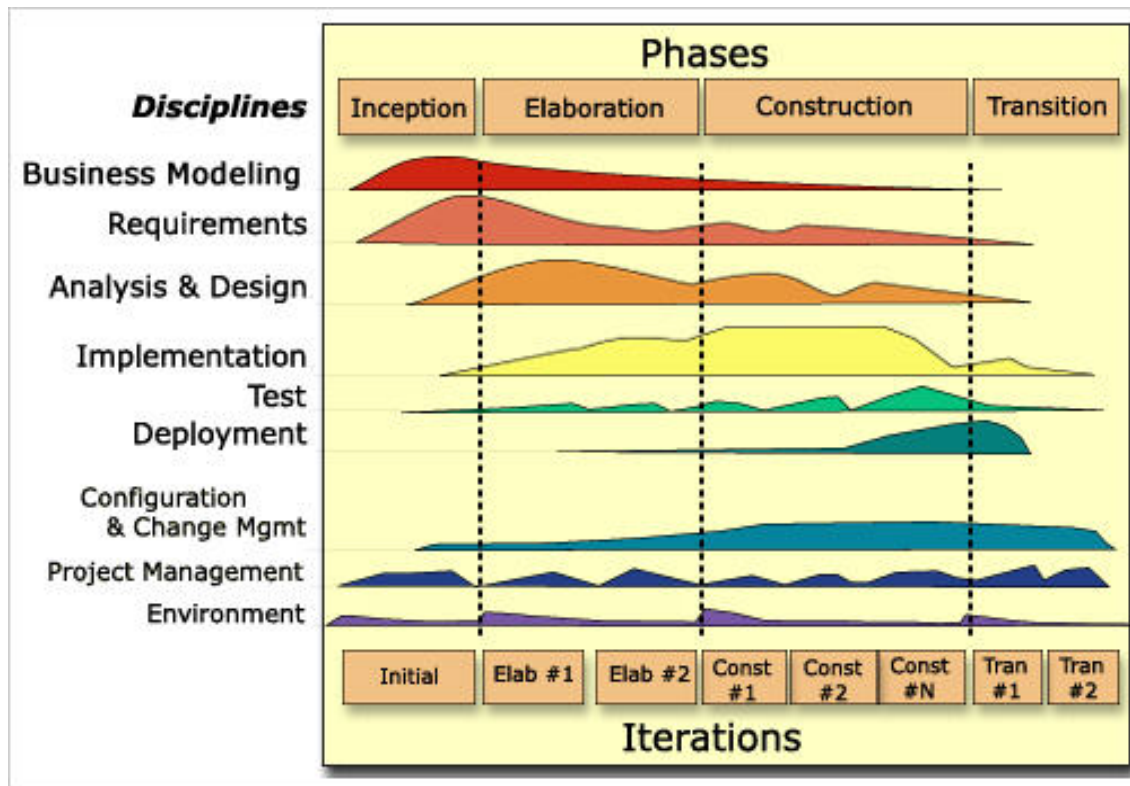
- New concept for providing health coverage
- Limited cycle time

Traditional Waterfall Process



- All requirements addressed at once
- Flow through phases one-by-one, addressing all requirements in each phase
- Big-bang!

- Workflows

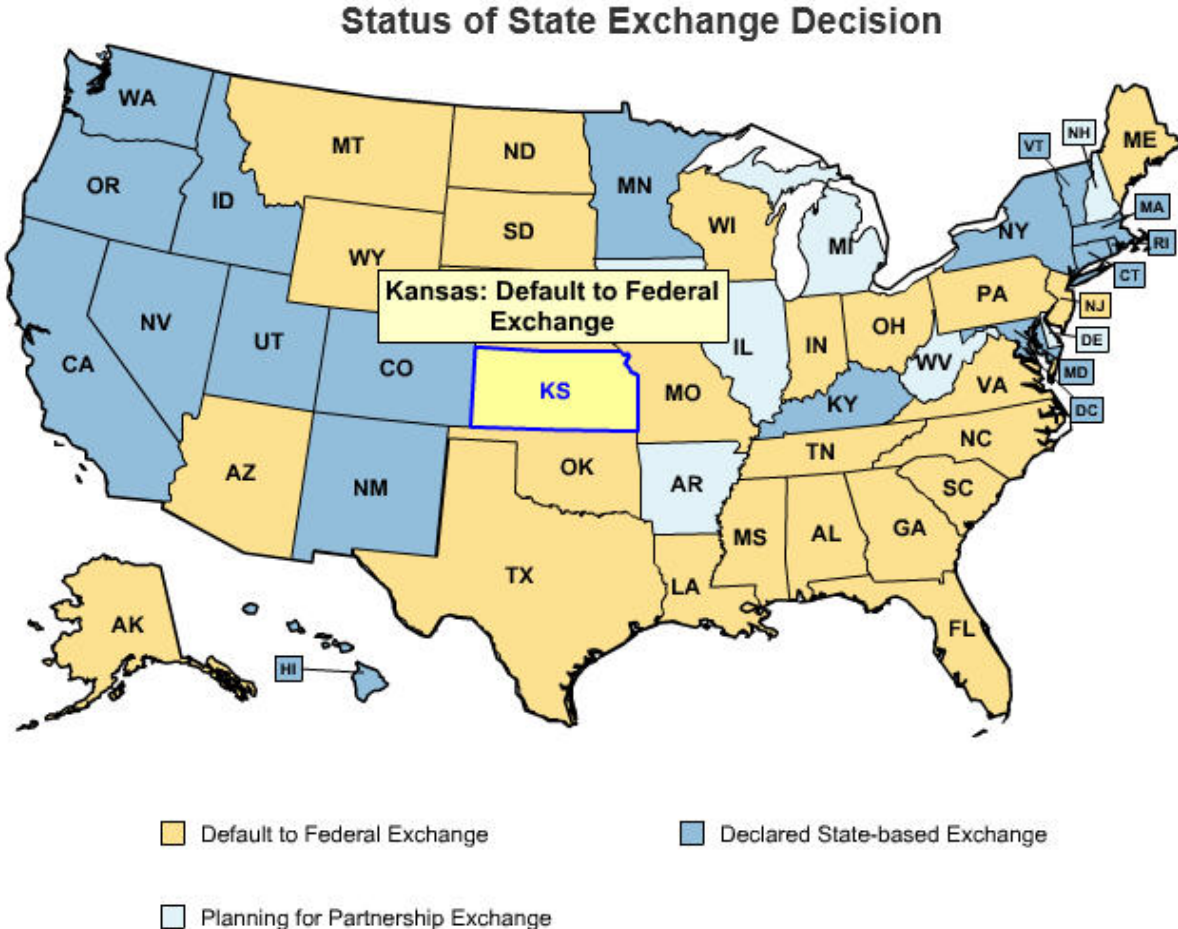
Iterative
