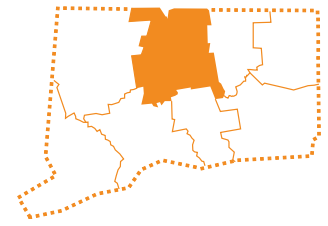


Making a difference in your community: Hartford County



Since 2013, we have helped more than 1 million individuals and small businesses, and the uninsured rate in our state has been cut in half. This means more residents are getting access to quality care, financial help, and preventive services that they need.

Enrollment in your community

- 24,075 residents enrolled in 2020 Qualified Health Plans during Open Enrollment and extension period.
- 199,187 residents were enrolled in Husky Health/Medicaid as of 1/15/20.
- Residents received an average of \$589.54 towards their monthly health insurance bill.

All health plans include:












- Preventive services – like annual checkups

- Services and devices for recovery from illness or injury

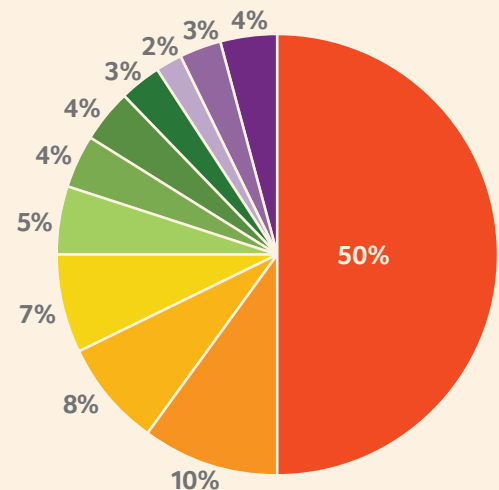
