HEALTH DISPARITIES

- **Interactive Website**
 - Clearly establish AHCT's organizational responsibility toward health equity by generating awareness of existing health disparities and informing end users of AHCT's roles and opportunities to improve health equity across Connecticut.

AHCT SUBSIDIARY

IT SYSTEM CHANGES

Based on the current system architecture assessment and corporate strategies, a 3 to 5-year plan will be created with the below building blocks:

- Strategically migrate core systems components to cloud-based and open-source solutions
- Create a new, modernized approach to AHCT's application architecture based on standards
- Enhance security and monitoring resources to be used in a proactive strategy to safeguard assets
- Decrease overall support costs for AHCT's application suite
